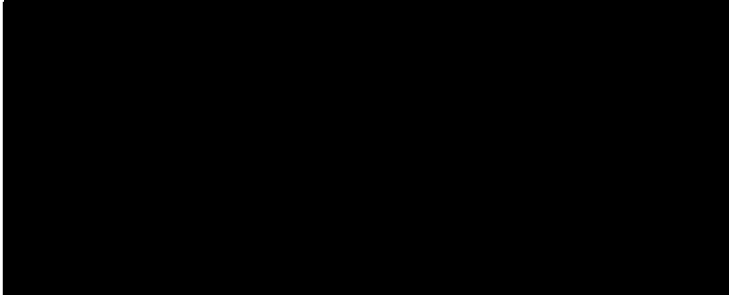

Re: Official Information Request – Covid case of 18 October moved to quarantine

I refer to your official information request dated 20 November 2020 and transferred from the Ministry of Health to Auckland DHB on 23 November 2020. You are requesting the following information:

I request all the information about the exact time that the community covid case reported on 18 October was moved to Quarantine, and all the information about the organising of his pick up.

I am responding from Auckland District Health Board (Auckland DHB) as the DHB responsible for Auckland Regional Public Health Service (ARPHS).

ARPHS provides public health services to all three metro Auckland District Health Boards – Waitemata District Health Board, Counties Manukau Health and Auckland District Health Board, and the populations they serve. ARPHS's core role is to protect and promote public health.

The case arrived at JetPark quarantine facility at approx. 1930hrs via his own private vehicle.
