Response:

No, there have not been any such instructions given. The DHB has a contractual obligation with senior doctors that supports doctor's rights and responsibilities a patient advocates. Senior doctors are firm in their commitment to this.

Our commitment as an organisation goes beyond that specific professional group. We encourage all staff to report adverse events so that we can learn and improve the quality and safety of our care delivery. We think we can improve our collective understanding and learning about why things don't always go well and how our systems and processes can be improved by sharing information about some of these cases more widely. This is why we publish short summaries of what happened, what our review found and what we're going to do as a result.
