Response

There is no data from 2018 as the system that records data on these matters was put in place in 2019. We are thus not able to search for information on allegations of bullying in the record system that existed prior to 2019. We are refusing this part of your request citing s18 (f) Official Information Act – the information cannot be made available without substantial collation or research.
