Re: Official Information Act request – Gender Affirming Surgery - ADHB Ref: 20220228-1226

I refer to your Official Information Act request dated 8 May 2022 requesting the following information:

- How many gender affirming surgeries have been undertaken in the past ten years through ADHB?
- 2. Could this please be separated by year?
- Could this also be broken down by type of gender affirming surgery? (E.g. chest surgery, (chest reconstruction to masculine) or chest surgery (breast augmentation), hysterectomy, oophorectomy, or orchidectomy.)

Response

The table below is based on patient events where the patient had a diagnosis of gender identity disorder and had a procedure that could be classified as gender affirming. In this response, we have withheld the information where the numbers are five or less under section 9(2)(a) of the Official Information Act 1982, as withholding of the information is necessary to protect the privacy of natural persons, including that of deceased natural persons. These numbers are marked at <5. We have considered whether the public interest outweighs the need to protect the privacy of individuals and have determined that it does not.

Counties Manukau Health provides the regional service for chest reconstruction/breast augmentation – the chest procedures included here are for mastectomy, breast excision or nipple reconstruction.
