# ...O&G?

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## Facts at a glance:

- The earliest point at which an application can be made for a non-RANZCOG training Registrar position is during Postgraduate Year 2 (PGY2) with entry for successful trainees in Postgraduate Year 3 (PGY3). At House Officer level, you are required to have completed at least 6 months of O&G.
- To be eligible to apply for the RANZCOG training programme, applicants must have at least 2 years of post-grad experience (ideally including 12 months of O&G as a HO or Registrar) at the start of the training year.
- In the 2015-2016 training year, 6 House Officers from the Auckland Region were College appointed to O&G Registrar positions (this includes House Officers who stepped up for the June-December period of 2015).
- There are approximately 41 O&G Registrar positions in the Auckland Region.
- There are approximately 236 O&G Consultants in NZ

## The six year post graduate training programme in O&G consists of:

- Core training involving a four year planned rotation between 3 hospitals, (includes a six month attachment at a provincial hospital), membership examinations and other training requirements resulting in membership of RANZCOG. Training can be part-time after the first year - which must be fulltime.
- Advanced training involves two years of advanced training which may be undertaken at an institution of the trainee's choice in NZ, or at an overseas hospital, with College approval. Please note, an application for employment must still be made with the relevant employer.
- Regular teaching is provided at each Northern DHB including mock examinations, and many national courses are run annually by the RANZCOG NZ Training Accreditation Committee
